PVC, BPA, PHTHALATE, CA PROP 65, PFAS STATEMENT FOR TI EDUCATION TECHNOLOGY (ET) PRODUCTS and RETAIL PACKAGING MATERIALS

Texas Instruments Education Technology products and Retail Packaging materials has gone through verification and design changes to ensure restricted hazardous substances are not present. The following statements are true:

- Does not exceed 0.1% by weight in homogeneous materials for Phthalates DEHP, BBP, DBP, DIBP
- Does not contain BPA (Bisphenol-A)
- Does not contain Per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) which are a group of chemicals that includes PFOA, PFOS.
- Plastic PVC has been removed from TI ET Products and retail packaging since 2017 with the transition to Plastic PET material that is safer for environment
- Conforms to CA Prop 65 List and does not require warning label
